


## SPECIAL LUNCHEON

## THE END OF AUGUST!

When the KLC Matching Funds Drive was started in April, it was stated that the goal was to raise \$250,000 in two months, in order to match the \$250,000 that had been designated as a matching funds gift to KLC from an anonymous individual's estate. As of the end of July, \$220,000 had been received toward that goal. That's 4/5s of the amount we are attempting to raise! That's awesome, amazing, and something to give thanks to God for.

While that two month period was extended by the executor of the donor's estate, the time has come to bring this drive to an end. It has been determined that this matching funds drive will conclude at the end of August. That means that there is only one month left to raise the \$30,000 that we need in order to take advantage of the entire \$250,000 in matching funds, which would then give the congregation \$500,000 to use toward the expansion of the KLC facilities.

## ALOHA FROM PASTOR DAVE



In Deuteronomy 11, God instructs the Israelites to teach his words to the children, doing so “when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up”. In other words, they are instructed to teach their children about God’s love and grace at all times and in all places.

We have just completed Vacation Bible School under the theme “Son Rock Kid’s Camp”. It was an amazing week where 50 keiki from KLC, the Tongan and Korean United Methodist congregations that use our facilities, and the Kihei community all learned about building their lives on the Rock, who is Jesus. If you want to see how amazing it was, go to the KLC website ([www.kiheilutheran.org](http://www.kiheilutheran.org)), and from there go to the KLC Facebook page. There you will find pictures of how the worship area was completely transformed into a camp ground, complete with a forest of trees, a huge tent that served as the story telling place, and a full array of animals from the forest. Each day 20+ high school youth and adults served together to provide a story time, crafts, snacks, games, and singing for everyone who came.

All of this brought home to me once again the importance of children in the life of the church, and making sure that they are raised in the knowledge of Jesus and his relationship with them. It also reaffirmed in my mind the fact that this congregation is so completely dedicated to our youth and God’s relationship with them. KLC is truly a place where it is understood that the youth are not only the church of the future. They are the church right now as well.

Because we feel so strongly about that fact, we are expanding our staff with a full time person in the area of Youth & Family Ministry. August 7-13, our #1 candidate for this position will be visiting, with his wife, from the Mainland. They will meet with a number of different groups from the congregation, including the young adults/marrieds/families, and the youth. There will also be a luncheon following worship on Sunday, August 12<sup>th</sup> (see related article on the front page), where the entire congregation is invited to meet and greet them. The purpose in adding a person to the KLC staff in these areas is so that we might lift up and affirm the importance of youth, as well as young adults, as full members of the congregation. This is something that we have been dreaming about, hoping for, and planning for, for well over a year. It’s exciting to see the plans finally coming together.

God calls us to raise our youth knowing who Christ is, and what he has done for us. This has been an important ministry at KLC, and continues to be so even to today. As we greet the candidate and his wife this month, keep those things in mind. We’re seeking to follow God’s will, both in terms of teaching our youth about Christ, and knowing the Holy Spirit’s guidance in bringing onboard an additional staff person to work in these areas. May God be with and direct what we do for his glory!

A detailed cost estimate is underway. Once we have the cost estimate, the team will prepare a draft implementation plan for review by the Church council at their September meeting. The next step will be to have the implementation plan presented and approved by the congregation by the end of September. We can then proceed with construction drawings and start the building permit process.

## BACK PACK BUDDIES

This September the KLC Community/Outreach Team will begin a new ministry called "BACK PACK BUDDIES" This is a program to provide nourishing child-friendly food to elementary school children who might otherwise not have access to meals over the weekend. The program

will provide weekend meals for children at Kihei Elementary School starting on September 20th. At the start of the program, 25 children in need will be identified by the school staff and bring their backpacks to a designated area on Friday mornings. We expect to expand the program to 50 students soon after and that it will continue to increase. On Wednesdays, a team of volunteers will package: 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners, 4 healthy snacks, and a piece of fresh fruit in a container to be placed inside each backpack for the children to pick-up before leaving school Friday afternoons. This will provide the child with good nutrition over the week-end.

Single servings of child-friendly foods will be collected during a food drive in September. Flyers with examples of these foods will be displayed at various locations through out the church facility. Some examples are: single serving boxes of cereal, oatmeal packets, canned chicken noodle soup (easy-open top), single serving of tuna/chicken salad, Chef Boyardee single serving meals, mac and cheese, apple sauce cups, fruit cups, granola bars, protein bars, fruit bars, mixed nut snacks and raisins.

Parishioners can be involved by contributing to the food drive and/or volunteering to help pack the meals. Monetary donations will also be accepted.

We know that there is a large hunger problem on Maui. This is the only program to address hunger in young children. A child needs good nutrition to grow and develop. Research has proven that well-fed children concentrate better, receive better grades in school, and have less developmental problems. They are happier and better-behaved.

Our children are our greatest resource and deserve to be well-fed. As Jesus said, "Feed my Sheep, Feed My Sheep, Feed my Lambs." I ask the Lord's blessing and the prayers of the KLC congregation on this new endeavor. May it grow and prosper.

*"Providing Spiritual Care and Education"*


### SPIRITUAL CARE VOLUNTEER TRAINING

Pacific Health Ministry is offering spiritual care training this year at Maui Memorial Medical Center in September and October. It will be conducted by Rev. Amy Crowe, the chaplain at the hospital. The program prepares attendees for visitation and care-giving in their congregations, or as a spiritual care volunteer with Pacific Health Ministry.

The classes begin on September 11th, and conclude October 16, 2012. Once a week on a week-day morning for two hours, classes will include many professionals and volunteers, who will share their knowledge about spiritual care, living with loss, cultural practices, and communication skills. Both women and men are encouraged to participate.



# BIBLE Treasure Hunt

### What you need:

### What you do:

#### Locations Treasure Hunt

1. Find Bible verses that mention a place inside or outside your house. The location for Matthew 7:8, for example, is a door.
2. Write each verse on a self-stick note and hide all but the first clue. Give the first clue to the player(s).
3. Leave the treats at the final clue destination.

#### Object Treasure Hunt

1. Find Bible verses that mention objects that can be found nearby. The object for Matthew 16:19, for example, is a key.
2. Give each player an empty box, a Bible and a list of verses as clues.
3. Have players return their collected items for a final prize.




## TRUE TREASURE



