GOAL REACHED

When the KLC Matching Funds Drive was started, the goal was to raise \$250,000 in order to match \$250,000 that had been designated as a matching funds gift to KLC from an anonymous individual's estate. As of the last Sunday of August that goal was reached through a gift! Mahalo ke Akua! Thanks be to God! The executor of the estate has been contacted, and a check for \$200,000 (\$50,000 has already been given) will be in the mail soon. This means that we will have over \$500,000 to start with as we move toward expanding the KLC facilities. How amazing is our God! Mahalo nui to all who gave gifts so that this goal might be reached.

But that's not the end of our need to raise funds. The congregation will still need additional financial support for the planned expansion. If you would like to contribute toward the project, please make your check out to Kihei Lutheran Church, and place "Building Fund" in the memo line. You can mail it to the church

at 220 Moi Place, Kihei, HI 96753, or drop it in the offering plate on Sunday. Mahalo nui for any gift, no matter the size, that you can offer. These are amazing days as we look to provide more space for all the ministry that's happening at KLC.

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING SCHEDULED

A meeting of the congregation has been scheduled by the church council for Sunday, September 23rd, beginning at 10:30 a.m., following the regular morning worship service.

One item on the agenda will be to ask the congregation to approve a specific plan for moving forward with the expansion of the KLC facilities. Building Team members will be present to share results of costs estimates that have been produced for the entire expansion project, as well as if the expansion were to be built in phases. There will also be discussion about the amount of funds KLC has available for the project, as well as how any additional funds needed would be raised.

The other agenda item will be to address changes that are being recommended by the Church Council and Youth & Family Ministry Task Force regarding the compensation package for the Youth & Family Ministry staff position. Please put this date on your calendar and make sure to attend this very important meeting on September 23rd.

September 16th.

On that day there will be an installation of teachers. Our class grades this year for the Keiki Class are ages K-5th, with rotating teachers. We are still looking for volunteers to assist. Our Jr/Sr High class will be taught by Barbara Rudow. We are beginning our school year with our 5th annual Keolahou Thanksgiving drive. On **September 30th**, we will start collecting donations of canned & boxed food items. Monetary donations will also excepted.

ALOHA FROM PASTOR DAVE

Each Sunday, before we speak the Prayer of the Day together, I say in Hawaiian what we normally say in English before we pray – "E Pule Kakou", or "Let us pray". I don't know that it's as obvious in the English, but it's very much so in the Hawaiian. In that phrase EVERYBODY is encouraged to pray. The word "Kakou" means that everyone present is to be involved. And in my mind

that's huge. It's huge because we're all called to be involved, not just a portion of us. We're all to be found praying, not just a handful of the group.

I mention this because September is going to be a very significant month for KLC. One look around will tell you what I mean. To begin with, many of the ministries that we carry out as a congregation will start up again after taking a summer break. Christian Education is the big one, with Sunday School and Adult Education beginning on September 16th. Then there's the choir, hula, and chimes that will all begin to practice again during this month. The choir on the 2nd, chimes on the 10th, and hula on August 30th (ok, it's close to September).

There will also be a new ministry – "Backpack Buddies" – that will start up in September, with members of KLC putting together backpacks full of food for students at Kihei Elementary school to take home with them on weekends so that they have something to eat. The plan is to start out with 25 students, and eventually expand it to 50 students. What an awesome opportunity we have to help those who have little or nothing to eat while they are away from the school feeding programs over the weekend.

The hope is that this will also be the month that we will get an official response from our candidate for the Youth & Family Ministry position. While there is no guarantee as to his response at this point, this will be the time that we will know if he accepts our invitation to come and serve at KLC, so these are important days from that stand point.

You will also see on the front page of this newsletter that a congregational meeting has been scheduled for Sunday, September 23rd. At that meeting the Building Team will present the cost estimates for our expansion project. There will be numbers of what it would cost if we were to build the entire expansion all at once, as well as what it would cost if we were to do the expansion in phases. There will also be conversation about what kind of funding we have available to us for the expansion project, along with talk about what we might want to do if we need to raise additional funds. There will be some big decisions that need to be made on that day.

And in the midst of all of this I would say, "E Pule Kakou!" Let us ALL be found in prayer. Let us be praying for those who teach Christian Education, do hula, sing in the choir, or play chimes. Let us pray for those involved in "Backpack Buddies". We need to be praying for both the candidate & KLC as we seek to come to a decision about him coming to Maui to serve. And we should be praying for God's guidance as we make decisions about the expansion of the facilities. With all of the important things that are going on in the life of KLC during September, how can we not ALL be found in prayer, asking for the Holy Spirit to guide each and every aspect of the life and ministry of the congregation. So, "E Pule Kakou!" Let us ALL be found in prayer during this month of September (& every other month for that matter!). God be with us all and direct all we do for his glory! Ke Akua me ke Aloha,

CONFIRMATION CLASSES

Conformation this year will take on a whole different schedule due to a number of the youth involved living outside of the Kihei area. Starting on **September 9**th, confirmation classes will take place on Sundays, following worship and Christian Education. While we are still with the single service format, confirmation will run from 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m., each Sunday. While this is not the most ideal set-up, it works for a number of our families who don't live right in Kihei.

These classes are part of the two-year confirmation process which gives 7th and 8th grade youth a chance to take a deeper look at their Christian faith, and grow in their understanding of God's relationship with them. At the end of the two years, each youth is asked to write a personal statement of their faith which they read to the congregation as they publically confess their desire to keep the relationship with God, that was begun at their baptism, a part of their life. 


