ALOHA FROM PASTOR DAVE

"I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1:3-6

After almost 20 years of writing a monthly "Aloha from Pastor Dave" article for the KLC monthly newsletter, this is my final one. It's bitter-sweet to sit at my computer and write it. But I'll tell you that there's never been a doubt in my mind as to what I wanted to say in this last article. The passage from Philippians 1 has been on my mind right from the beginning. That's because there are two very important things from what Paul writes that I want to say to all of you.

First, <u>I thank God for you!</u> These years at KLC have been an absolutely amazing experience for me in every respect. The partnership that we have shared in carrying out ministry in the name of Jesus Christ has been a phenomenal blessing to me in ways that I can't even begin to express. We have experienced God's direction and hand in the life of this church so many times that I've lost count. Every time I've turned around, God has been using different individuals to make another miracle happen. That's been the theme of these years. It's simply been one "God Thing" after another. Please know that I will truly pray for all of you on a regular basis, and will do so with great joy and thanksgiving in my heart for the opportunity I have had to serve our Lord alongside you.

Second, God's not done with you yet! In Paul's words, "...he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." I am convinced beyond a shadow of a doubt that the ministry God has been working through the people of KLC will carry on in the days, months, and years ahead — until the day of Christ Jesus. I'm been watching it happen ever since I announced my retirement on June 1. You haven't sat back and stopped doing ministry. You've recommitted yourselves to making sure that the ministry that is currently happening will continue to do so, even in the midst of a time of transition. I've seen it in so many people. It tells me that "he who began a good work in you", that is, the Holy Spirit, will continue to empower you to keep up the ministry you're doing. That's an awesome promise from God that will keep you moving forward in your lives of service to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The last thing I want to do is simply to say "Mahalo nui loa (Thank you so very much)" for the opportunities you have given me to live out the Calling God put within me to serve as a pastor. I have been blessed beyond my ability to comprehend by living and serving our God with all of you these past years. I will miss all of you, KLC, and Maui more than you will ever know. But I'm also completely convinced that God's got allot more in store for you. May his Holy Spirit guide and fill you always!






