ALOHA FROM PASTOR DAVID

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ,

Aloha from Colorado! Both Karen and I are waiting with eager anticipation to be among you and experience life in Hawaii once again. Although Colorado is a very beautiful state and we have a magnificent view of Longs Peak (14000 feet) from our living room window, our hearts continued to long for the gentle, gracious, and wondrous environment called Hawaii.

When Bishop Finck emailed me last April and wondered if I would be interested in another assignment in Paradise, I copied his email, hid it behind my back, and told Karen that I was holding both her birthday and anniversary presents in my hands. When she read the email, she wept with joy.

Karen and I just recently celebrated our 49th anniversary. We have two sons: Tim lives in Loveland Colorado, and Andrew and daughter-in-law Nora live in Newbury Park, California. We have three grandchildren: Kaari, Christian, and Ella. We also have two fur children, Girly-girl and Mr. Mugs, a feral and an abandoned cat from Oahu and the Big Island. We still have another month to fulfill the Hawaiian requirement regarding animal quarantine so Karen will not be joining me until November 3.

I have served congregations in Lander, Wyoming; Loveland, Fort Collins, and Windsor, Colorado; and Honolulu, Kailua-Kona, and now Kihei, Hawaii. Wherever we have lived and served, we have met marvelous people, experienced many new adventures, and have rejoiced and given thanks for the opportunities God has placed in our hands. As I look at your new pictorial directory, I am struck by two observations: First, as I look at your pictures, I wonder about all the interesting stories that accompany those faces. As with past experience, I know that you, too, will enrich and bless our lives; Second, I am greatly impressed with the ministry that you have accomplished together. Certainly Pastor Dave and Kathy have provided faithful, dedicated, and competent leadership, but you obviously have responded with joyful and willing hearts to accomplish good things in Kihei. Because the Holy Spirit is alive and well bearing fruit in your lives, I am deeply honored to lead you in this time of transition.

O God, you have called your servants to ventures of which we cannot see the ending, by paths as yet untrodden, through perils unknown. Give us faith to go out with good courage, not knowing where we go, but only that your hand is leading us and your love supporting us; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

With this promise, both of us look forward with joy and delight to being with you, living with you, and helping you discern where the Holy Spirit is calling you for the next chapter of Kihei Lutheran Church.




SEPTEMBER ANGELS




