REPORT OF THE MAY 19 COUNCIL MEETING

Council continues to do the work of the church via Zoom meetings. The most recent meeting was May 19.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: There is \$59,483.20 in the general fund. This figure includes the \$38,788 Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan which leaves an actual working balance of \$20,695.20.

Since KLC must apply for forgiveness of the PPP loan, the Finance Committee will keep diligent watch over the process required as information is available and may evolve.

Council accepted with regret the resignation from Jack Jorden. This leaves us with three vacancies in unfulfilled terms. We were pleased to fill one of those vacancies by approval of Joel Rudow to serve until May 31, 2021. The KLC Constitution allows Council to elect a successor in the event of a vacancy prior to the next annual meeting.

The Lenten appeal to pay down the mortgage principle brought in a total of \$37,300. This amount has been paid directly to the principle. This will be most helpful since lower principle means lower interest being paid monthly.

Drive-by communion is being planned for Pentecost on May 31. See the article elsewhere in this newsletter.

All members of Council will become part of either the Finance Committee to assist with applying for forgiveness of the PPP loan or the Worship Committee to discuss safe re-opening of in-person worship. These are temporary assignments to assist with these two immediate needs.




