Council Secretary's Report from the February 2022 Council Meeting

A regular meeting of the KLC Council was held virtually via Zoom with a quorum present. The meeting was opened with a devotion and prayer by Renee Romerdahl.

Pastor Joel did not submit a report due to his absence.

Renee reported that she finalized the Little Hoku preschool lease, and she also finalized KLC facility use by the AARP for tax preparation. The streaming technology is up and running. The time and talent sheet was revised with Marilyn Hopkins' assistance. Renee also attended the virtual 'Bishop's Conversations with Congregational Presidents' meeting.

Margie provided the Treasurer's report. KLC has a bank balance of approximately \$46,264. Year to date income was \$42,067; and year to date expenses were \$31,069.

The Noisy Offering collected will be donated to the Tongan tsunami relief effort.

The next regular virtual meeting will be March 22nd at 7:00pm.


