## ATTENTION KLC COMMITTEE HEADS AND CONGREGATION



A regular meeting of the KLC Council was held virtually via Zoom with a quorum present. The meeting was opened with a devotion and prayer by Sue Moorcroft.

Renee has been working on pulpit supply. Don and Cate Sauer will provide worship music during Beth's absences in January. Renee expressed her thanks for the Council and the work they have accomplished this year.

Margie reports that by the end of the month KLC will have a bank balance of approximately \$17,000. Year-to-date income was \$264,235; and year-to-date expenses were \$280,788. Weekly giving last week was \$1,976.

Council voted to call Pastor Ron Rucker to serve as our Interim Pastor. Council is excited for what the future holds.

The next regular virtual meeting will be January 24th at 7:00pm via Zoom.


