PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Presidents Message

I am pleased to tell you that the Transition Team is finishing up their work and will have the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) ready for the council to review at the June

Church Council Meeting. Thank you to all of you for expressing your voices and for sharing your thoughts and opinions with the team through the group meetings and surveys. A special thank you also to Mark Haley, Zel Terluin, Vicki Nelson, Dave and Heather Ballaine, and Sally Handley for serving on the Transition Team. Once the MSP is approved by council it will be reviewed by a synod staff person, and will then be activated and shared with potential candidates.

We are now ready to form the KLC Call Committee. "The purpose of the call committee is to identify the candidate who is best suited to lead the congregation into God's future. The work of the committee must be done prayerfully, and the people on the committee must be open to the movement of the Holy Spirit. The call committee is not looking to clone a former minister(s), nor the exact opposite, or a innocuous person to hire. Rather they are looking for the 'right' candidate to call at this particular time and place for this particular congregation. It is important not to come with a predetermined mindset or personal bias. Each member must see beyond his or her own wants toward achieving the greater good." (*Quoted from the ELCA Call Committee handbook*)

During the next few weeks, we will be taking nominations to serve on the Call Committee. You may nominate yourself or another individual that you have spoken to and who indicates they would like to serve on the committee. You will also be asked how the person would be beneficial to the call process. Nominations are due by Sunday, June 16. The Church Council will review the nominations and will then elect the Call Committee during their June meeting.

The Call Committee has many responsibilities and will meet frequently. Meetings are usually every week or every other week, and some weeks there will be multiple meetings. The Call Committee develops and determines interview questions, prepares informational packets for each candidate, reviews oral and written information about candidates provided by the Office of the Bishop, interviews the candidates, maintains total confidentiality during the interview process, communicates regularly with the congregation in general terms about the call process, and encourages continuous prayer for the committee and the entire congregation during the call process. All conversations during the call process must be kept confidential to the official meetings of the call committee.

The call process will take time. We do not expect that we will be able to quickly find a pastor for our congregation. It could take months or years until we find the right person to lead our congregation. We are not in a hurry, and we **will not** rush this process. We have the support of the Bishop in taking our time and Pastor Ron has stated he will extend his interim ministry during our search. I do ask that you stay open to where the Holy Spirit is leading our congregation, to pray for our congregation, the Call Committee and for the pastor HE will send to us.


COAT Continues


